



Slater's 50/50 Las Vegas Dishes to Diplomas Program

Upon being hired to the Slater's 50/50 team and performing well over the 90-day probationary period, eligible team members must submit a reimbursement form indicating which courses the team member is enrolled in and receive written confirmation from the general manager prior to the start of the semester. Within 60 days after the end of the semester, the team member must provide an official transcript to the general manager for reimbursement.

Dishes to Diplomas requirements include:

- Team member is enrolled in a full-time program at UNLV or CSN and studying toward a two-year associate's degree or four-year undergraduate degree during the qualifying semester.
- Tuition reimbursement is based on the undergraduate Nevada resident rate during the qualifying semester. Non-residents will be reimbursed at the Nevada resident rate.
- Courses must count toward student's degree. Only in-classroom courses will qualify for reimbursement.
- Maximum reimbursement is 12 credits per semester, or 24 credits per academic year.
- Team members must maintain, at minimum, 40 available hours per week for shift scheduling.
- Team member has worked at least 625 hours during the six months prior to the semester ending.
- Team member has no discipline records for one year prior to semester's end.

Once approved for the program, reimbursement is based on academic performance with an A- and above earning 100 percent tuition reimbursement and a B to B+ earning 50 percent tuition reimbursement.
